Q1. The Next Generation Energy Act indicates that Applicants will need to complete their own benefit-cost analysis (BCA) as part of the submission requirements. Is this a requirement of the Request for Applications?

To ensure that CBAs employ consistent assumptions and reliably reflect the relative value offered by Applications, the RFA Administrator will be conducting a benefit-cost analysis on all Applications deemed administratively complete. Applicants do not need to submit their own cost-benefit analysis as part of the submission requirements.
